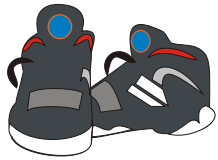


THE ROANOKE RIVER RENAISSANCE II FESTIVAL

We would like to draw your attention to some of the outdoor activities and opportunities in the Roanoke area. Boating, Biking, Hiking, Birdwatching, etc
There will be many activities during the day at Wasena.

Boaters: Float from Rotary Park (419 & Lee Highway) in Salem to the upper end of Wasena Park in Roanoke (About a 5.5 mile Float)

A shuttle will be provided from Wasena Park to Rotary Park. Drop off your gear at the put-in (Rotary Park), drive to Wasena Park and take the shuttle back. There will be someone at the put-in to watch your gear.

Shuttle starts at 9am and ends at 12:30pm. Depending on water levels, trips last from 45 minutes (High water) to normal 3.5 hour trip

Walk around the park or ride a bike from Wasena Park to Bennington St, SE. New section added at Rke Mem Hospital. An easy 5.5 mile bike ride (11 miles round trip)

So get up and get out. Come and join us at Wasena Park! Bring the kids, bikes, and boats. Float the Roanoke River, walk a trail, ride your bikes or just to get out and be in the park.
